Socio-economic growth in both developed and developing countries reflects the country's endowment of human resources. Both positive and negative aspects like infrastructural development, improved transportation, poverty and unemployment have to be taken into consideration with priority while thinking on human resource development. 'Population studies' is an important area of Human Geography. Inadequate or excessive population is a challenge before economic growth and development. Populations are not internally homogenous in terms of spread of socio-economic capital. In India, social stratifications shaped by history are reflected in the status of communities. Many measures in terms of special programmes and policies were adopted in independent India to diffuse historical disadvantages.

An analysis of these policies and programmes in terms of their rationale, effectiveness and outcome is necessary. Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes are relatively neglected communities in development discourse. This National Seminar aims to increase the awareness about socio-economic status of SC and ST populations. Regional patterns of development, migration and tourism are related areas of study that are linked with socio-economic status of marginalised communities. The seminar aims to produce concrete recommendations to enhance the socio-economic status, inclusion and standard of living of peripheralized communities in India and forward those to Maharashtra State Government as well as different NGOs working in the area.

About Kolhapur




About the College
