

Interview of Mr. Prakash Patil

Head Master-Dyanaprabodhini Sanchalit Andh Shala(Blind School) at Mirajkar Tikti, Kolhapur City.

Q. When did the school get government grant?

Ans-Since from the year 1989 the school is getting government grant from Maharashtra state, before that the school used to run on private funds received from the donations, we got from the society and well-wishers. It is only after when we got government grant that we selected permanent teaching staff, before that all the staff was on temporary basis.

Q. What were the difficulties that you had faced during the starting years?

Ans-When the school was not receiving government grant, the payment of teachers and staff was not possible, so we taught free of cost and every day we struggled to find students. So we tried different ways to get students to our school, like going to grampanchayat, and doing survey. After getting grant we advertised and so many students along with their parents approached us.

Q.Which type of special help do you get from the government?

Ans- We purchase books, medicines, uniforms with the help of government grant that we receive.

Q.Is there any type of training to the teachers?

Ans- Of course, all the teachers have to complete D.Ed.In our case, as this a school for blind children they have to do D.Ed specially designed for teaching people with physical disabilities. We can proudly tell you that our teaching staff is well qualified. Besides that we would like to inform you that three of our teaching staff are blind but they are very capable teachers. Also people from various NGOs are associated with our school and contribute their help.

Q.What other activities that you carry out besides studies?

Ans-We celebrate all the birth and death anniversaries of our national heroes. We also organise competitions like Essay writing, general knowledge test, singing, sports for blind, cultural programmmes etc. We are proud to inform you that we send our students to take part in district and state level competitions like singing, instrument playing etc. Especially I want to mention that we send students to give exams of Gandharva Mahavidyalaya of music, before that we give them extensive training.

Q.Is there any lodging and boarding facility for the students?

Ans-We are having hostel facility for all the students, because if they come from home to school then they have to engage a person to drop and pick up them. Here we have a staff of 14 members which include cook, care taker, teachers, peon and they all are government servants who help them.

Q.Any more help that you would like to get form the government?

Ans-We have applied to the government for a suitable piece of land to build a big building where the blind students will have ample free space, modern infrastructure and facilities.

Q.The books that the blind students use having Braille script are made by you or do you purchase them from outside sources?

Ans-We have machinery and equipments to make basic books in Braille script. For other books we purchase them from outside sources.

Q.What do you expect from the society?

Ans-We only expect that, the general public should treat blind people with respect and dignity. They should know that they also have special talents which should be properly channelized. If the blind people are given education and training they can also stand on their own and contribute to the society and live a dignified life.

A Report

Visit to Blind School

Objectives:

The aim of the visit is to encourage our students to collaborate with community-based organizations and institutions to promote a just and humane society.

- To prepare students to engage in meaningful service.
- To inculcate a sense of commitment for social work.
- To provide awareness among students for their social responsibilities.
- To provide specialized services to visually challenged children so they can improve their ability to live and function in the community.

Our goal is to develop the strong and engaged relationships with members of the visually impaired community as well as with service organizations. By organizing such activities, we provide our students opportunities for hands-on learning. We introduce them for addressing the various environment-related problems and needs in the local community.

To widen the horizon of the students, the teachers of Department of English, work rigorously. In this academic year, the students visited the school of blind children called *Dyanaprabodhini SanchalitAndh Shala* as a social outreach programme on 25th January 2019 situated at Mirajkar Tikti, Kolhapur. The school is a Govt granted institute having lodging and boarding for blind children.

Students of Department of thought to share their knowledge with visually impaired children. Hence they went to the school to spend some time with them under guidance of teachers of English Department. The teachers of that school introduced blind students. They were gathered in a small hall. The blind students introduced themselves. Our students -Amey Kavthekar, Adarsh Ingawale and Manali Patil taught them rhymes and grammar of English. They entertained the students by telling them horror comedy. The blind students enjoyed English poems, stories and comedies told by our students.

The blind school teachers demonstrated the Braille script. One of them read the Braille script book. We played games with them. Omkar Buchade sung a melodious patriotic song. The blind students also sung songs. Later, our students


took small interview of the teachers in that school. This was a marvellous intraction.

By offering snacks to the blind students, we moved to see how blind people use mobile phones and Whatsapps. We gave them chart papers by which they make Braille textbooks. With host of beautiful memories we clicked group photo. All the students were very happy. We really feel that one should become more socially conscious. There is a need to show love and care about deprived groups of our society. We would like to express our deep gratitude to the Prin. Dr. S. Y. Hongekar for his generous support.
