A Visit to Shivaji University Library and Language Lab. – A Report

Objectives:

- To acquaint the students of the functioning of university library.
- To give exposure of the university campus to the students.
- To introduce the language lab to the students situated in the English dept. of the university.
- To make the students aware of the higher learning environment available at the university.

Steve Pinker once said."The language we use influences the way we think." And how we not admit the fact told by Johann Wolfgang Von Goethe saying "Those who know nothing of languages know nothing of their own."

Well,that was the main reason behind our study tour to Shivaji University Kolhapur,the most well-equipped university in Maharashtra.A group of 56 students from B.A.I,II and III on 21st August 2018,decided to visit the university's modernized English lab and also the largest library facility built for the sake of students enlightenment.The faculties members named Mr.S.M.Ruikar,Prof.Prasenjit P. Gavali,Prof.Sandeep A. Patil went with the students.We reached at the library at 11:00 a.m.,but the actual visit started at 11:30 a.m.We first decided to visit the English Language Lab.Here it should be noted that our university has one of the most modern and finest language lab.It is well-equipped with computers and always has the internet facility.The lab has a learning system which is based on LSWR(Listening,Speaking,Writing,Reading)method.Here,the students are provided with headphones which follow a unique style of developing the language.Students can improve their English by just doing the activities they are given by the lab officials.It is a great useful way to get students interested and engaged in English so that it can open a large array of career opportunities for them.

Our next spot was the library.It was previously called as "Barrister Balasaheb Khardekar Library'.But now it is renamed as 'Barrister Balasaheb Khardekar Knowledge Resource Centre'.As the name suggests it certainly has a resourceful management.Dr.Namita Khot is the head of library.Our instructor and guide there was Bhagyashree Gurav who patiently took us on a journey to an immensely

sophisticated place. This library was established in 1962. The library follows all modern world's rules and systems, which is kept for easy public access. The library has over 3,00,000 books which are orderly kept in 8 sections such as Stack section, Archival section, Reference section, Thesis and Dissertation section, Periodical section, Internet section, Circulation section and Book Order section. Afterwards Mr. C.N. Gurav took us to the different sections of the library. The library follows decimal system of book-keeping and management. It also has the OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) system which is for everyone who wants to issue a book. Most of the books are classified by the surnames of the writers alphabetically. A unique thing which we noticed was the use of 'surrogate card' that is to be used by someone who's is not familiar to the order of the books. One can get access to any book by just using this surrogate card and even need not to worry about forgetting its place. It is a helpful thing which maintains order of books and also saves our time.

Later on, Mr. Raju Bumale joined us as our instructor and guide to show us the specialty part which is none other than the Archival section. It is often called as 'Record section'. It has the largest collection of rare books, novels, periodicals, papers, manuscripts, coins and a lot more. It uses the modern technology for books' safety. They have a fumigation room wherein the bookbinding is also done so as to keep them recovered and useable. The library is enriched with books of history from as old as 1857. It also showcases the famous collections such as Dr. Dhananjay Keer collection, Barrister P.G. Patil collection, which is a treasure to M.Phil and Ph.D students. One particular and unique section of the library is the Thesis and Dissertation section. It is a grand collection of every thesis of doctorate passed out from Shivaji University. It has a website named 'Shodhganga', which helps us to search the book we need.

The next section is the Circulation section. Here, we can issue any book by a simple authentication process managed by Mr. A.B. Matekar and Dr. D.B. Sutar. Based on our library card, we can lend any book with the help computerized barcode reading system.

After that we were taken to the Periodical section. It has a great storage of periodicals, journals, newspapers. Then the Internet section is a place not to be forgotten. It can aptly be called as the 'brain of the university' as it manages to keep

all the data and information of give and take of knowledge. Last but not the least, 'The Reading Room'. The reading room is a spacious hall provided with all kinds of facilities for up to 1000 students at a time. It follows thumb impression system so that no intruders can be allowed. It has some special adjustments for handicaps. It is a highly secure place guarded by CCTV cameras and is open between 06:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Here our visit came to an end.

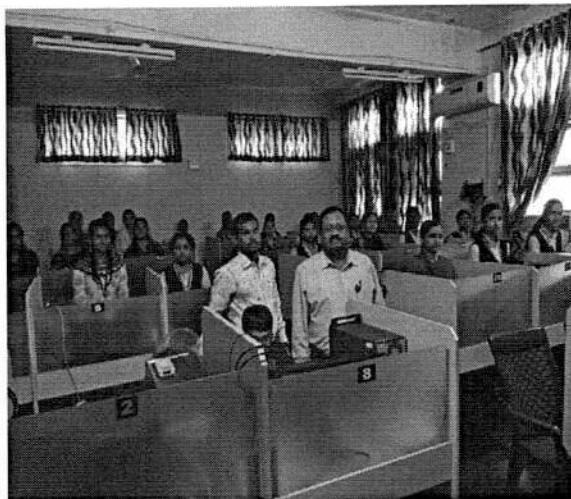
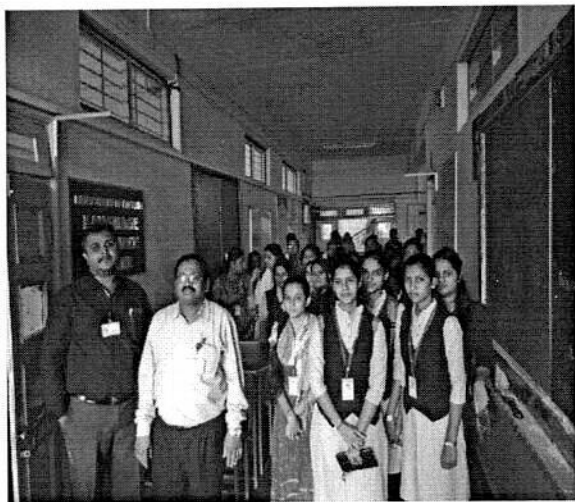

We fly to heaven....."

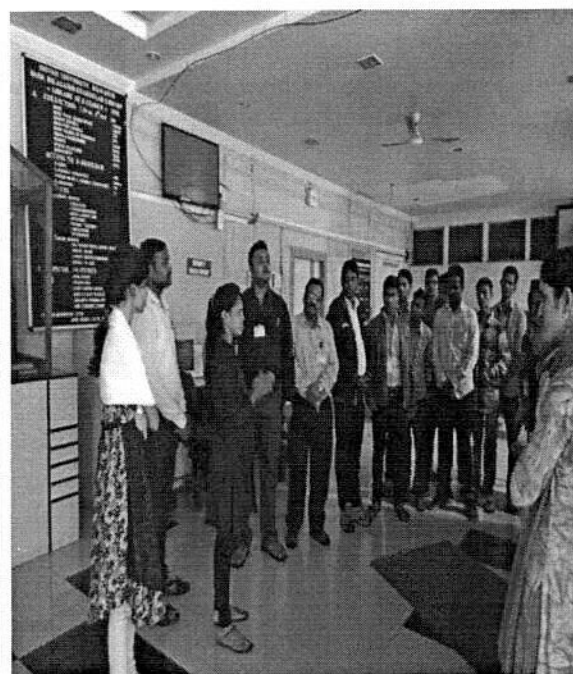
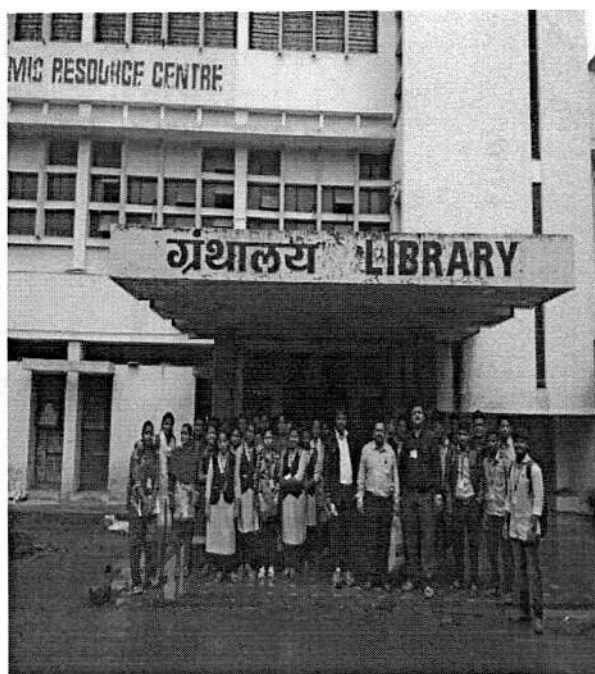
