Brief Description:

The National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) comes under the Ministry of Statistics and Program Implementation headed by the Director-General is responsible for the conduct of large-scale sample surveys in diverse fields on an All India basis. Primarily data is collected through nation-wide household surveys on various socio-economic subjects, Annual Survey of Industries (ASI), etc. Besides these surveys, NSSO collects data on rural and urban prices and plays a significant role in the improvement of crop statistics through the supervision of the area enumeration and crop estimation surveys of the State agencies. It also maintains a frame of urban area units for use in sample surveys in urban areas.

We were guided by the host Mr. RAMESH MINA, Senior statistical officer (SSO) and office incharge. He explained in detailed about the achievement of current post and functioning of NSSO. Also he explained nature of work of his colleagues on various fields of NSSO. He introduced us about Ministry of Statistics and Program Implementation.

After that Umesh Kumar Mandal, Junior Statistical Officer (J.S.O.) thoroughly explained the recruitment process of NSSO. He shared the knowledge about the exams conducted by Staff selection commission for Junior statistical officers and investigators. Also he informed about UPSC examination for Indian Statistical Service (ISS) and Indian Economic Service (IES).

He gave us information about ongoing survey schemes: AYUSH, HCES and emphasized on main motto of NSSO of conduction of large scale sample surveys regarding policy making. Mithlesh Kumar Senior Statistical Officer, Rinku Jain and Kunaw shaw informed us about future opportunities in the field of statistics.

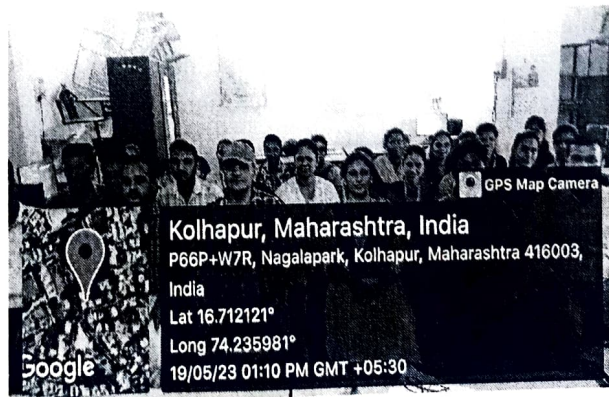
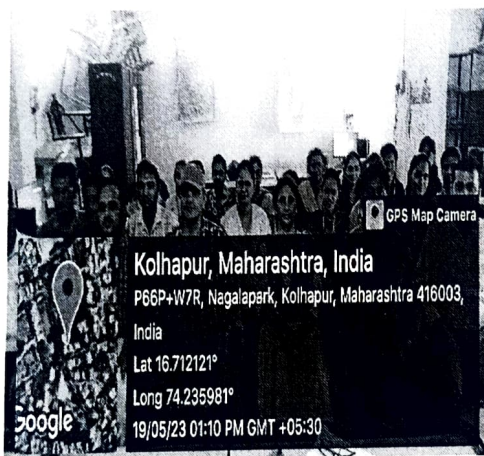
The question answer session between us and host took about half an hour. We noted about their work as a statistician and collected many posters related to various schemes of NSSO.
