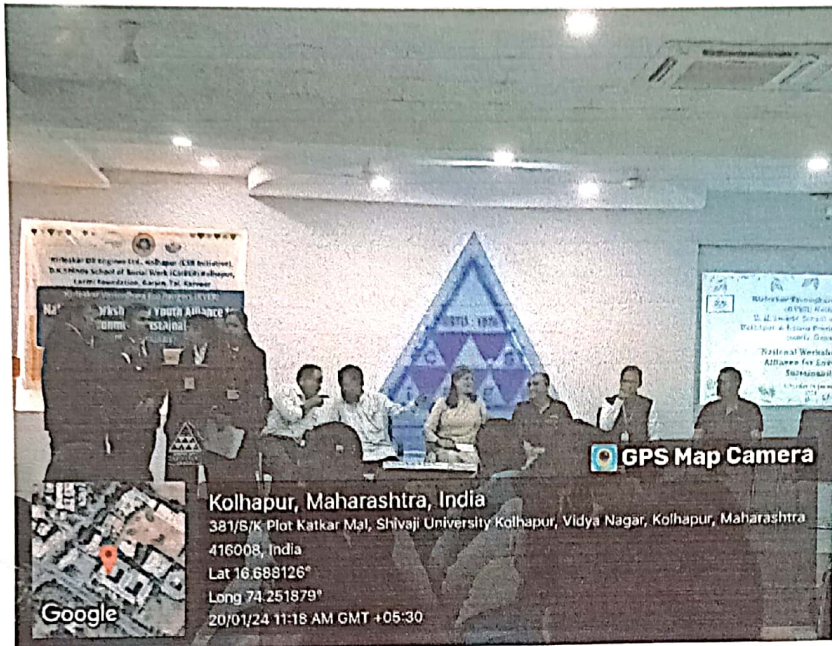

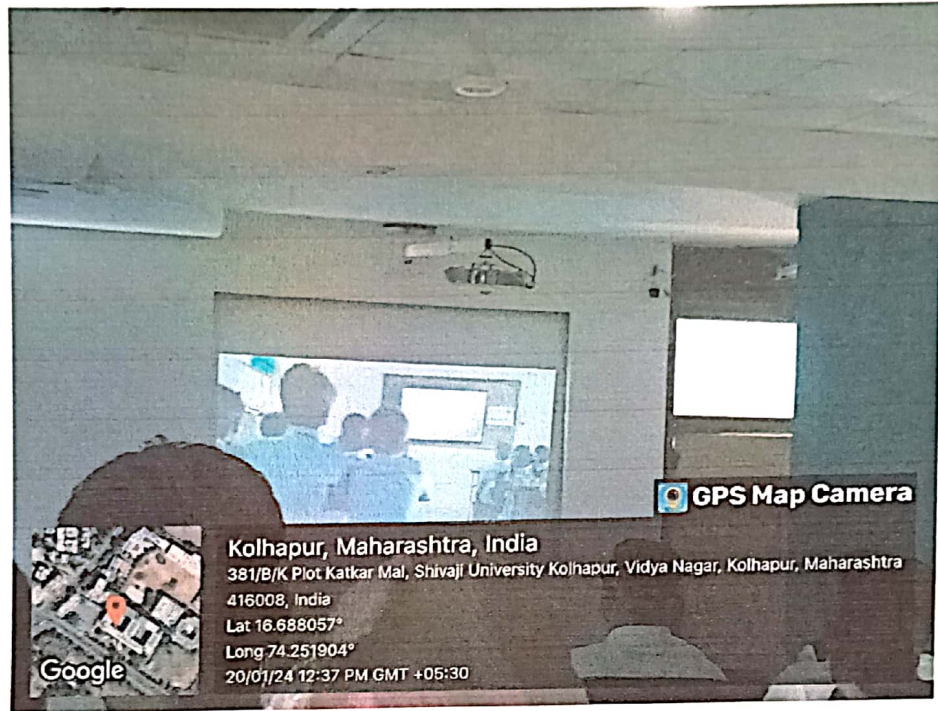

The organization also conducts research, builds capacities, and mobilizes communities to address the environmental challenges facing India and the world. Through education and



awareness, the organization hopes to create a generation of responsible consumers and citizens who can lead the change towards a greener and fairer society.

#### 8. Outcome

A total of 5 students participated in the one-day national workshop on Youth Alliance for Environment Sustainability, 2024. Youth Alliance for Environment Sustainability, 2024 successfully achieved its aims and objectives by implementing various projects and activities that involved youth participation and leadership.

- The organization contributed to the Global Youth Declaration on Environment, which was presented at the Sixth session of the United Nations Environment Assembly (UNEA-6) in 2024.


- The organization conducted a nationwide survey on the environmental attitudes and behaviours of young people in India, and published a report with recommendations for policy makers and practitioners.


- The organization organized the GO4Youth Olympiad, an online event that tested the environmental knowledge and skills of students aged 18-25, and awarded scholarships and internships to the top performers.


- The organization partnered with local NGOs, schools, and colleges to deliver environmental education and training programs, reaching over 10,000 young people across India.
