1. **Plant Kingdom**– Five kingdom, Classification of plants – Algae, Fungi, Bryophytes, Pteridophytes, Gymnosperm and Angiosperm. (Examples of each): Structure, reproduction, evolutionary significance, distribution in India and economic potential.
2. **Cell Biology** – Structure of plant cell, Prokaryotic and Eukaryotic cell, Cell organelles, Cell division - Mitosis and Meiosis, Techniques in cell biology.
3. **Plant Physiology** – Photosynthesis – Light and Dark reaction, Factors affecting and importance of Photosynthesis, Respiration – Aerobic and Anaerobic , Transpiration and Water transport, Plant Growth Hormones.
4. **Plant Anatomy and Morphology**–Study of Meristematic and Permanent tissue, Anatomy of root, stem and leaf, Study of morphology of Flower, Types of fruits and seeds
5. **Reproduction in Plants**–Asexual reproduction – Budding, Vegetative propagation



Sexual reproduction – Pollination, Double Fertilization. Seed formation and germination.

6. Ecology and Environment –Ecosystem Basics (Producers, Consumers, Decomposers), Adaptations in Plants (Xerophytes, Hydrophytes, Halophytes), Role of Plants in Environment (Oxygen, Carbon Cycle).

7. Plant Utility and Exploitation–Origin of cultivated plants(Vavilov's Centre), Plants as a source of : food, fodder, fiber, spices. Food: Rice, Wheat, Maize. Pulses: Gram, Pea, Lentil. Oil Seeds: Mustard, Sunflower, Groundnut .Fibres: Cotton, Jute.

Medicinal Plants: Tulsi, Neem, Aloe-vera.

8.Genetics and Evolution –Mendel's Laws (Monohybrid and Dihybrid Cross), Concept of dominant and Recessive traits, Variation and Mutation Basics.
