In consonance with established academic and teaching traditions, and with a view to reinforcing a student-centric and caring approach the teachers are encouraged to work with students, beyond the structure of classroom teaching. Student feedback and teacher response plays a catalytic role towards improvement in teaching-learning and institutional development.
