I am pleased to inform you that you have qualified the UGC-NET for Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) held on 29th JUNE, 2008.

You are now eligible for availing Junior Research Fellowship (JRF). The validity period of the offer is two years from the date of issue of this letter. The commencement of fellowship will depend upon your joining M.Phil/Ph.D. programme. In case you have joined M.Phil/Ph.D. programme prior to the declaration of NET result, you will be eligible to get the fellowship from the date of declaration of NET result, i.e.,4th November, 2008.

It may please be noted that the candidates qualified for JRF can avail the fellowship through recognised universities/institutions in accordance with the procedure already communicated to them. Therefore, for availing the fellowship, you are advised to contact the university/institution in which you have already registered/wish to register for M.Phil or Ph.D. programme.

The concerned institution should verify the orginal certificates of the candidate. Wherever PH or VH appears in the UGC-REF. Number, the relevant documents of physical or visual disability should be checked. It should also be verified whether the candidate fulfils the minimum eligibility conditions for Junior Research Fellowship (JRF), i.e., at least 55% marks in Master's Degree (or) equivalent examination from a university/institution recognised by UGC for General/OBC and 50% for SC/ST/PH/VH candidates within two years from the date of declaration of UGC-NET result.

The age of the candidate should not exceed 28 years as on first day of the month of the concerned UGC-NET, relaxable by five years for SC/ST/OBC/PH/VH/Female candidates. Relaxation in age up to three years is provided to candidates who have done LLM and to research scholars for the period of research. Total relaxation on the above ground(s) cannot exceed five years.

The certificate for Lectureship eligibility is being issued separately.
