Aims and Objectives : To provide practical training in nature and landscape photography using natural light and professional Canon equipment.

Brief description : An outdoor photography workshop was conducted at Radhanagari in association with Canon. The workshop focused on landscape, nature, and wildlife photography. Under the guidance of experts, students practiced framing, composition, and understanding natural lighting in an open environment. They also got the opportunity to test various Canon lenses, including wide-angle and telephoto lenses, and learned how to adjust camera settings (shutter speed, aperture, ISO) quickly in changing weather and light conditions.

Outcomes : Students gained hands-on experience in outdoor and landscape photography. They learned how to effectively use natural light to enhance their compositions. The practical use of different Canon lenses helped them understand equipment selection for specific outdoor scenarios, significantly boosting their confidence in field photography.
