STUDY TOUR REPORT (2022-2023)

Introduction: In the academic year 2022 – 23, Department of Physics had organized study tour at Hampi, Badami dated from 28th January 2023 to 30th January 2023 for T.Y. B.Sc. (Physics) students. All about 10 students and 02 teacher, Prof. C. J. Kamble (Head) and Dr. S. I. Inamdar (Tour In-Charge) were participated in Study Tour.

Objective: The expected outcome includes providing situation for the student – teachers to learn and get acquainted with the process of organising a study tour and understanding the environment around. Tour Report: Our journey started from college campus at 07.00 AM with the guidance of our Principal Dr. R. R. Kumbhar. We reached our first destination Vijapur at 12.00 noon on the same day. Vijapur city is known for historical monuments of architectural importance built during the rule of the Adilshahi dynasty. Our first stop in Bijapur was Gol Gumbaz which is the mausoleum of king Mohammed Adil Shah, Sultan of Bijapur. Gol Gumbaz is circular dom. It was constructed such that, voices from the top of the dome would reverberate and would be heard by everyone in the vicinity. We reached our designated hotel in Badami on Sunday night at 10.00 PM.

On Monday, after quick refreshment, we headed to Badami Cave temples. Badami was the capital of Chalukya rulers from 540 AD to 757 AD. The caves are considered an example of Indian rock-cut architecture. Our exploration was made informative by guide who took us to all the temples and gave interesting information on the deities, the history of temple and much more.

Hampi is undoubtedly the most gorgeous Indian destination. The landscape is very evocative and the ruins are still alive. It was home to Kishkinda empire mentioned in Ramayan, then one day it was sacked and looted by Muslim invaders. Nevertheless, landscape is the same, the ruins are still magnificent and the whole area is very evocative of the past. The rocks are gorgeous, the architecture blends in perfectly with them.
