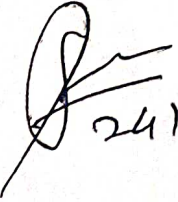

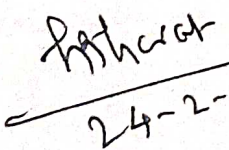

A guest lecture on "What Do Footprints Tell Us" by Dr. S. D. Pawar highlighted the practical importance of statistics in analyzing patterns and making decisions. He explained how footprints and data act as evidence that help in drawing conclusions about real-life situations. Through simple and relatable examples, he demonstrated the use of statistics in areas market analysis, healthcare and daily decision-making. The lecture also highlighted concepts such as data collection, interpretation and the role of probability in predicting outcomes.
