- 1. Name of Organized Activity: Celebration of National Statistics Day at NSO
- 2. Date/ Duration: Tuesday, 1st July, 2025. (2 hours)

3. Aim and Objective:

- To honour the contributions of Dr. P.C. Mahalanobis to the field of statistics and economic planning.
- To spread awareness about the role of statistics in socio-economic development.
- To introduce students to the structure and functions of the National Statistical Office (NSO) and create awareness about career opportunities in the field of statistics and government statistical services.

4. No. of beneficiaries:

Teachers: 03 Students: 11 girls and 14 boys

Brief Description:

The National Statistics Day is celebrated every year on 29th June to commemorate the birth anniversary of Dr. Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis, the renowned Indian scientist and statistician. He is best known for introducing the Mahalanobis Distance, a key concept in multivariate analysis, and for founding the Indian Statistical Institute (ISI) in 1931. The day aims to raise awareness about the importance of statistics in policy formulation and socio-economic planning.

The program began with the lighting of the lamp in front of the photograph of Dr. Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis, as a mark of respect and tribute to the legendary statistician. As a part of the celebration, the National Statistical Office (NSO) organized a special program in which our college students actively participated. The event included informative lectures and discussions focused on the role and functions of NSO, along with creating awareness about career opportunities in the field of statistics. It served as a valuable learning experience, helping students understand the practical applications of statistics in government and public administration.

The National Statistics Office (NSO), operating under the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation and headed by the Director-General, is responsible for conducting large-scale sample surveys across diverse fields on an all-India basis. Primarily, the NSO collects data through nationwide household surveys on various socio-economic subjects, such as the Time Use Survey (TUS), the Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS), and the Annual Survey of Industries (ASI). In addition to these surveys, the NSO gathers information on prices in both rural and urban areas and oversees the area listing and crop estimation surveys conducted by state agencies, thereby contributing significantly to the improvement of crop statistics. Furthermore, it maintains a frame of urban area units to facilitate sample surveys in urban regions.

We were guided by Mr. Vedant Kondkar, Assistant Director (AD), who provided a detailed explanation of the achievements associated with his current position and the functioning of the National Statistics Office (NSO). He also elaborated on the roles and responsibilities of his colleagues across various fields within the NSO. Additionally, he introduced us to the structure and functions of the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation. Following this, he provided a comprehensive explanation of the recruitment process at the NSO. He shared insights into the examinations conducted by the Staff Selection Commission (SSC) for the positions of Junior Statistical Officer (JSO) and Investigator. Additionally, he informed us about the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) examinations for recruitment into the Indian Statistical Service (ISS).

The question-and-answer session with the host lasted for about half an hour. We gained valuable insights into the work of statisticians and collected several posters related to various NSO schemes. The information shared by the host was extremely beneficial and will undoubtedly help us in our future endeavours. They also assured us of their support in preparing for statistics-related examinations and in conducting surveys for data collection.

At the conclusion of the visit, Ms. Pallavi Ransubhe, Assistant Professor, Vivekanand College, Kolhapur delivered a vote of thanks to all the NSO officers for generously sharing their time and knowledge with us. Mr. Abhilash Patil, Ms. Ashiyana Makandar and Ms. Pallavi Ransubhe, faculty, Vivekanand College, Kolhapur accompanied us during the trip, which concluded at approximately 2:00 PM.

Outcomes:

- 1. Celebrated the birth anniversary of Dr. P.C. Mahalanobis and honoured his contributions to the field of statistics.
- 2. Students learned about the recruitment process at NSO and the structure of competitive examinations such as the Indian Statistical Service (ISS) and Junior Statistical Officer (JSO).
- 3. Students received detailed information about various ongoing sample surveys conducted by the NSO.
