8. Outcomes:





Study Tour Report B. Sc. II - (Pune – Bamnoli - Wasota)

A study tour is not just a pleasure trip; it enhances the knowledge of the students beyond the four walls of the classroom. To provide such an enriching experience to students, Department of Zoology, Vivekanand College, Kolhapur (Autonomous) has organized a two days study tour of B. Sc. Part II students as per part of curriculum of B. Sc. Part-II Zoology, Vivekanand College, Kolhapur (Autonomous) to Pune - Bamnoli – Wasota on Monday, 11/04/2022 and Tuesday, 12/04/2022. Total 52 students and 5 teachers have participated in the tour. All COVID-19 pandemic guideline of Maharashtra state were followed by participants. The main objective of study tour was to bring students in vicinity of nature and learn through experience. Study tour emphasizes experiential learning and offer both group and self-directed activities that enable learners to explore various places and activities.

The study tour was started at 6.00 am from Vivekanand College, Kolhapur (Autonomous) by private vehicle (traveler). Study tour reached The Rajiv Gandhi Zoological Park, Pune at 12.00 pm. Visiting a zoo brings human beings closer to these living beings. It makes human beings develop a liking for animals and birds. They play a vital role in uniting and educating students about characteristics, nature and behaviors of animals. When students as visitors watch a species of an animal they learned about how and where these animals live, about the climate, and the habitat in which they thrive naturally. Afterwards students enjoyed their lunch from 3.00 to 4.00 pm and headed to Bamnoli for stay. Students were mesmerized by the panoramic views on the ways from Pune to Bamnoli. Bamnoli lake, famous for its natural beauty, is a major tourist attraction located in the Satara District of Maharashtra, at distances of about 36 km from Satara City. Bamnoli is a village situated on the banks of Shivsagar Lake, which is a backwater lake in the vicinity of Koyna Dam, constructed on River Koyna. This lake was good attraction of Satara district. Water was cleaned and cool. Many trees attractive surrounded to this lake makes it more beautiful.

On next day, (Tuesday, 12/04/2022) after breakfast tracking for the Wasota fort was started. From Bamnoli there were boats to reach at the base of the Wasota fort, 1 to 1.5 hrs boat

ride in the Shivsagar Lake water to start trek. Along the way students have observed some breath-taking views of the mountains surrounding the lake. At a distance of 18 km from Bamnoli, Wasota Fort is an ancient hill fort (elevation 3600 ft / 1100 m) is in Koyna Wildlife Sanctuary and is part of Sahyadri Tiger Reserve. It has taken approximately 3 hours to reach to the top of the fort and requires a lot of walking. The person who took us by boat accompanied us till the top of the fort and he was very kind to help us. The Matoshri nivas, Bamnoli Kasbe, (our stay) packed our food (chapati bhaji) for lunch at the top. Trek was started by 10.00 am after paying entry fee 30rs per person and checking plastics in our bags (they check it after coming down so one doesn't throw plastic and food waste in the reserved forest, to make sure no one litter in the nature). We have deposited Rs. 500 which was refundable if the count of plastic matches after returning from fort. The trek had approximately 3 kms of walk with lesser gradient and last 1km was the difficult steep climb. But the view students get worth the sweat while climbing. They say "the best view comes after the hardest climb". All tiredness was gone when eyes saw the best view one could ever see. The fort is not well resorted so one can just see some remains of it and a mandir. Students had lunch under a tree shed and we were ready to descend at 2.00 pm. It took us 2.30 hrs to climb down i.e., 4.30 pm. The forest is a reserved home to many Bengal tigers and other animal species. Wasota to Bamnoli journey was also through boat. After tea and breakfast at stay tour started return journey to Kolhapur. Tour reached to Kolhapur at 11.30 pm.

Dr. G. K. Sontakke, Ms. N. A. Patel, Ms. K. L. Kamble, Ms. Y. S. Pujari, and Ms. P. S. Shetfalkar guided the students in study tour. Student returned to home with happy faces and with acquired knowledge in tour.
