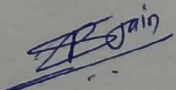
Mentor Mentee Report – B. Sc II (Major Zoology) Term I

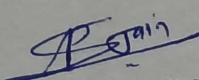
Mentor Mentee Report – B. Sc II (Major Zoology) Term II

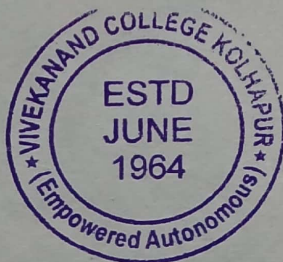

Overall, the mentoring scheme in Term II proved beneficial in ensuring continuous student support, improving retention, and contributing to their holistic development.

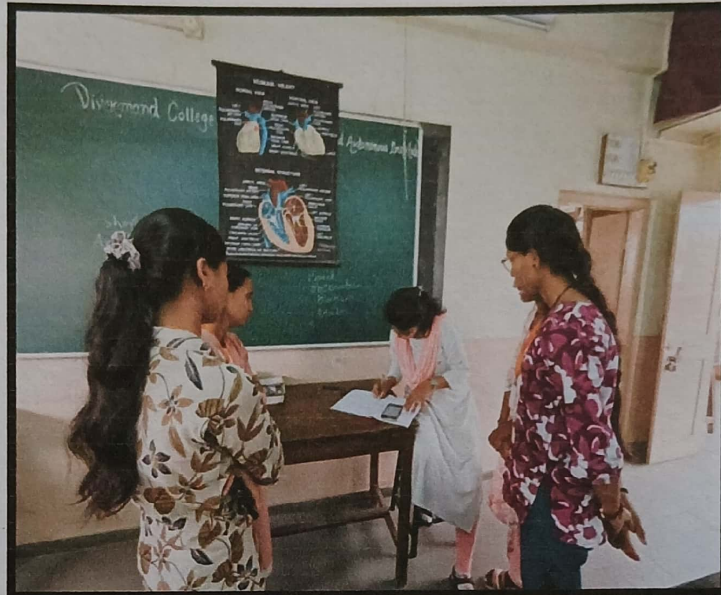
