

Code of Conduct

A) Code of conduct for Student

- It is mandatory for all the students to attend all lectures, practical's, tests, tutorials, seminars, examinations etc.
- 2. The student should take their work seriously and maintain at most discipline to keep up the dignity of institution.
- 3. The students shall give respect to all teachers and staff members.
- If student is found indulging in any act of indifference, he/she may be terminated from college.
- Scribbling on walls, desk or defacing the building is responsible and will attract punishment.
- 6. The use of unfair means by students at any examination will invite severe punitive and disciplinary action under rules and regulation now in force.
- 7. Every student should wear his/her ID with in college premises and ID card must be produced whenever asked for by any of the college authority.
- 8. The students should attain functions like Independence Day, Republic Day, college day etc. and lectures organized by college and respective departments.
- 9. Ragging is strictly prohibited. If student found indulging in the ragging will be expelled from the college.
- 10. The college enforces a dress code for all the students.
- 11. Use of mobile phone in college campus and classroom is strictly prohibited.
- 12. Student four wheelers are forbidden in college premises.
- 13. Visitors are not allowed to meet the students in the classrooms.
- 14. Students are not permitted to circulate any printed materials or pamphlets without the permission of the principal,
- 15. Students shall move from one classroom to another or get out of the classroom in an orderly manner.
- 16. During leisure hours students should go to the study room, library or internet browsing centre

B) Code of conduct for Teachers

- 1. Teacher should obey the orders of the principal
- 2. Teacher should provide an innovative and quality education to students.
- 3. Interact with the students in classroom a friendly manner.
- Principal has rights to use the services of the teachers in academic and non-academic activities.
- 5. Teacher should take permission from the principal for any type of leave application.
- 6. Teacher's academic performance is reviewed by the principle every year.
- 7. Follow the all rules and regulations of the institution.
- 8. Physical presence of the teacher is compulsory during the working hours of the college.
- 9. In case of emergence, the teacher has to take permission for early going or late going.
- 10. Except on health grounds, no teacher in permitted to absent from extra duties examination work, event management arranged by the college authorities.
- 11. Use of mobile phone in classroom is strictly prohibited

C) Code of conduct for non-teaching staff

- 1. Report to duty at least 20 minutes in advance
- 2. Maintain honesty, integrity, fairness in all activities.
- 3. Exercise self-discipline and restrain at all times and deal positively with staff, students and the general public
- 4. Respect and maintain the hierarchy in the Administration.
