

- 16. During leisure hours students should go to the study room, library or internet browsing centre


B) Code of conduct for Teachers

In order to counteract the threat of ragging, foster positive connections between students on campus, and implement anti-ragging regulations in accordance with guidelines from the Maharashtra government, UGC, and Supreme Court of India, colleges have established anti-ragging committees and squads.
