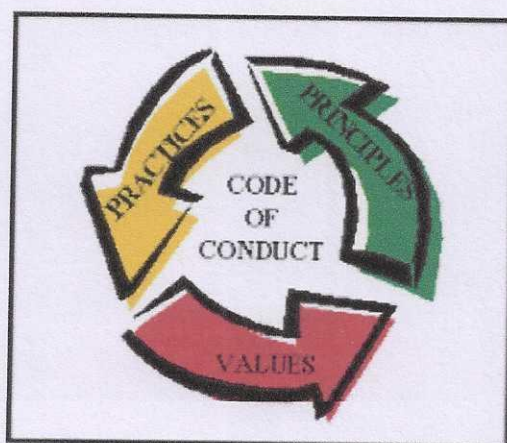

A) Code of conduct for Student


1. It is mandatory for all the students to attend all lectures, practical's, tests, tutorials, seminars, examinations etc.

4. If student is found indulging in any act of indifference, he/she may be terminated from college.
5. Scribbling on walls, desk or defacing the building is responsible and will attract punishment.
6. The use of unfair means by students at any examination will invite severe punitive and disciplinary action under rules and regulation now in force.
7. Every student should wear his/her ID with in college premises and ID card must be produced whenever asked for by any of the college authority.
8. The students should attain functions like Independence Day, Republic Day, college day etc. and lectures organized by college and respective departments.
9. Ragging is strictly prohibited. If student found indulging in the ragging will be expelled from the college.
10. The college enforces a dress code for all the students.

CASE STUDY 3ऑनलाईन शिक्षण आणि भारतातील शिक्षणाचा
दृक्क

2020 हे वर्ष जगभरात कोवोनाचा हाहाकार माजवणारे ठरले. 2020-21 म्हणजे कोवोना महामारी ही इतकीच छाप या कोविड - 19 विषाणूने या वर्षावर ओडली आहे. कोवोना विषाणूची साथ हे दुसऱ्या महायुद्धानंतरचे जगासमोरचे मोठे संकट आहे. मानवी जीवनाच्या सर्व बाजूवर या संकटाने प्रभाव टाकला आहे. हा रोग आटोक्यात आणण्यासाठी सर्व देशांनी लॉकडाऊनचे धोरण स्वीकारले भावतानेही ते स्वीकारले. या लॉकडाऊनमुळे सर्व व्यवहार ठप्प झाले. या महामारीने कोणत्या क्षेत्रावर परिणाम झाला नाही असे नाही. अनेक लोकांचे बळी गेले. अनेक बेरोजगार झाले पण तितकाच वाईट परिणाम हा शिक्षण क्षेत्रावर झाला आहे. मार्च 2020 पासून देशात सर्व शाळा, महाविद्यालये आणि विद्यापिठे बंद झाली. शाळा, महाविद्यालये आणि शिक्षणसंस्था बंद पडल्यामुळे विद्यार्थ्यांच्या शिक्षणाचे मोठ्या प्रमाणात नुकसान झाले. आणि त्यामुळे विद्यार्थ्यांना ऑनलाईन शिक्षण देण्याचे सरकारने ठरवले. पण खरेच या ऑनलाईन शिक्षणाच्या धोरणामुळे प्रत्येकाला शिक्षण घेता येते का किंवा प्रत्येकाला शिक्षणाचा दृक्क मिळतो का हे पाहणेही तितकेच गरजेचे आहे.

सर्व शाळा आणि महाविद्यालयांनी विद्यार्थ्यांना डिजिटल प्लॅटफॉर्मद्वारे शिकवण्यास सुरुवात केली. परंतु याचा जास्तीत-जास्त फायदा हा शाहू व श्रीमंत विद्यार्थ्यांनाच विद्यार्थ्यांचे घर शकतात. समस्या आहे ती बहुसंख्य कळकळी, गरीब वर्गातील, भटके, आदिवासी, ग्रामीण भागातील सरकारी किंवा अनुदानित शाळात जाणाऱ्या मुला-मुलींची. शाहूपासून दूरच्या खेड्यांमधील विद्यार्थ्यांना इंटरनेट कनेक्टिव्हिटी

खराब असल्यामुळे किंवा स्मार्टफोन नसल्यामुळे शिक्षण घेण्यास बराच त्रास सहन करावा लागत आहे. भारतात आज कोट्यावधी कुटुंबे आहेत की ज्यांना इंटरनेट जोडणी परवडत नाही. युनेस्कोच्या अहवालानुसार भारतात 15 लाख बाळा बंद आहेत. त्यामुळे 26 कोटी विद्यार्थी घरी बसले आहेत तर उच्च शिक्षणात 50 हजार शिक्षणसंस्था बंद आहेत व 3.70 कोटी विद्यार्थी घरी बसले आहेत. पण ह्या सर्वच विद्यार्थ्यांकडे स्मार्टफोन किंवा इंटरनेट कनेक्शन असलेच असे नाही. म्हा अहवालानुसार भारतातील 100 कोटी लोकसंख्येपैकी फक्त 30 कोटी लोकांजवळ स्मार्टफोन आहेत तर दुसऱ्या म्हा अहवालानुसार भारतात 52 टक्के जनता इंटरनेटचा वापर करते. म्हणजे निम्म्या भारत इंटरनेटच्या लाभापासून वंचित आहे. ग्रामीण भागात 36 टक्के जनता व शहरात 64 टक्के जनता इंटरनेटचा वापर करते. तर 67 टक्के पुरुष व 38 टक्के स्त्रिया भारतात इंटरनेटचा वापर करू शकतात. ओडिसा, वेस्ट बंगाल कर्नाटक व मूंबई सवा अनेक राज्यांमधील खेड्यात फक्त 9 टक्के लोकच इंटरनेटचा वापर करतात. भारत हा खेड्यांचा देश आहे. येथील बरीच जनता गरीब आहे. त्यामुळे सर्वांनाच स्मार्टफोन, कंप्युटर व इंटरनेटचा खर्च परवडत नाही. त्यामुळे ऑनलाइन शिक्षण ही गोष्ट सर्वांना परवडणारी नाही आणि याच कारणांमुळे भारतातील असंख्य विद्यार्थी या कोरोनाच्या काळात शिक्षणापासून वंचित राहत आहेत. शिक्षणात आलेल्या या व्यत्ययाने मुलांना शिक्षण हक्कांपासून वंचित वहावे लागत आहे असे मत युनेस्कोने नोंदवले आहे.

शिक्षणाचा हक्क हा एक वैश्विक हक्क आहे. एक म्हा हक्क जो मानवी हक्क म्हणून ओळखला जातो. आर्थिक, सामाजिक आणि सांस्कृतिकवरील आंतरराष्ट्रीय करारानुसार शिक्षणाचा हक्क म्हणजे सर्वांसाठी मुक्त सक्तीचे प्राथमिक शिक्षण तसेच माध्यमिक शिक्षण सर्वांसाठी वापरण्याजोगे करावे म्हणून एक बंधन तसेच ज्या लोकांनी आपले प्राथमिक शिक्षण पूर्ण नाही केले त्यांच्यासाठी

पायाभूत शिक्षण देण्याची जबाबदारी मुद्र्या शिक्षणाच्या एकात येते. आपल्या भारतीय राज्यघटनेतील कलम 21 म-नुसार शिक्षणाचा अधिकार हा 2009 मध्ये (RTE 2009) मुलभूत अधिकार मानण्यात आला आहे. त्याद्वारे 6 ते 14 वर्षे वयोगातील मुलामुलींना मोफत व अक्लीच्या शिक्षणाची तरतूद केली आहे. 21 व्या शतकात शिक्षणाबाबत दुसरा पर्याय नाही. शिक्षण आपल्या बुद्धीला चमक प्रदान करते. आपल्या विवादांना उच्य करते. तसेच आजच्या स्पर्धेच्या युगात एक चांगली नोकरी मिळवण्यासाठी शिक्षण अत्यंत महत्वाचे आहे. शिक्षण व्यक्तीला मानसमान व उच्चास्थिती प्रदान करते. शिक्षण समाजातील लोकांना इतरांविषयी नैतिकता आणी शिळाचाव शिकवते. त्यामुळे शिक्षण हा मुलभूत एकक असायलाच द्या तसेच ती सर्वाना मिळायला द्या.

परंतु या कोरोनामहामारीच्या काळात आपण वर पाहिल्याप्रमाणे अनेक लोक या एकापासून वंचित राहत आहेत. सरकारमुद्र्या या महामारीमध्ये मुलामुलींना मोफत व अक्लीचे शिक्षण देण्यास अपयशी ठरत आहे. त्यामुळे शिक्षणशिक्षणाच्या या एकाची पायमल्ली झाल्याचे दिसून येते.

पण माझ्यामते जर आपण सर्वजणून विचार केला तर ह्या परिस्थितीसाठी आपण जबाबदार किंवा विशिष्ट मुका घटकाला दोष देऊ शकत नाही कारण ही एक नैसर्गिक आपत्ती आहे. जी कोणीही मुद्र्यास नाही ओढवून घेतलेली. मला मान्य आहे की शिक्षणाचा एक हा रूप महत्वाचा आहे. पण अध्याची परिस्थिती अशी आहे की आपले जिवंत राहणे हे जास्त महत्वाचे आहे. हा काळच असा आहे की ज्यामध्ये आपल्या शिक्षणाच्या एकाचीच नाही तर आपल्या अनेक मानवी एकांची पायमल्ली होऊ शकते. अनेक लोक आपल्या एकांपासून वंचित राहू शकतात. परंतु ज्यामध्ये कमीत-कमी लोक शिक्षणाच्या एकापासून वंचित राहणेत म्हणजेच जास्तीत-जास्त लोकापर्यंत शिक्षणाचा एक पोहोचवा यासाठी सरकारने चांगल्या योजना

ह्या आखल्याच पाहिलेत आता जे कोठा विद्यार्थी ह्या ऑनलाईन शिक्षणाचा लाभ घेऊ शकत नाहीत त्यांच्यासाठी सरकारने सज्जातीचे रुजळणी वर्ग घेण्याचे आदेश काढावेत जेणेकरून त्यांचे जे शिक्षणाचे नुकसान झाले आहे त्याची थोड्याप्रमाणात तरी भरपाई होईल.

तसेच सरकारने सगळे करून देवातील ज्या भागात कोरोना रुग्णांची संख्या कमी आहे किंवा जेथे कोरोना रुग्णांचे नसतील अशा ठिकाणी सुरक्षित अंतर ठेवून व योग्य ती काळजी घेऊन तेथे शाळा, महाविद्यालये सुरू करण्याचे आदेश द्यावेत.

सरकारने रेडिओ, दूरदर्शनवरून शिक्षण देण्याची जी योजना सुरू केली होती ती पुन्हा पद्धतशीरपणे व प्रभावीपणे सुरू करावी, जेणेकरून अनेक विद्यार्थ्यांना त्याचा लाभ घेता येईल.

तसेच सरकारने ग्रामपंचायतींना गावामध्ये वाय-फाय सुविधा सुरू करण्यासाठी आर्थिक मदत करावी, जेणेकरून इंटरनेट-सुविधा उपलब्ध होऊन अनेक ग्रामीण भागातील विद्यार्थ्यांना ऑनलाईन शिक्षणाचा लाभ घेता येईल.

कोरोनाविषाणूमुळे निर्माण झालेल्या परिस्थितीचा सामना भविष्यात आपल्याला अजून किती दिवस करावा लागेल हे सांगता येत नाही. या ऑनलाईन वर्गाची मागणी जसजशी वाढत जाईल, तसेतसे ऑनलाईन शिकवणीच्या व्यवसायात गुंतलेल्या कंपन्यांचे संकट वाढू लागेल. त्यामुळे असा मुक टप्पा येईल की सुरुवातीला मोफत ऑनलाईन शिक्षण देणाऱ्या या कंपन्या त्यांच्या सेवांसाठी चांगला दाम मोडून घेऊ लागतील त्यामुळे अनेक विद्यार्थ्यांना या सवाळ्य सेवा सुरूकामुळे ऑनलाईन शिक्षण परवडणार नाही त्यामुळे या कंपन्यांनी सेवा शुल्क घेऊ नये किंवा घेतुलेच तर ते सामान्य जनतेला परवडेल असे घ्यावे असे सरकारने कायदे तयार करायला हवेत.

ह्या नैसर्गिक आपत्तीमध्ये शिक्षणाचा हक्क देण्याची जबाबदारी जशी सरकारची आहे तशी काही प्रमाणात ती भाई-वडीलांची सुद्धा आहे. असे मला वाटते. ज्या ६ ते १४ वर्षातील विद्यार्थ्यांचे भाई-वडील सुरक्षित असतील त्यांनी आपल्यापरिने मुलांना शिकवण्याचे

- To ensure fair and timely resolution of sexual harassment complaints
- To provide counselling and support services on campus
- To ensure that students, faculty and staff are provided with current and comprehensive materials on sexual harassment.
- To promote awareness about sexual harassment through educational initiatives that encourages and fosters a respectful and safe campus environment

The committee seeks to inform the campus community of their right to a respectful work and learning environment. It believes that if we practice respect, exercise empathy in our interactions with others so that we do not hurt anyone through what we say or do, then we can create a campus that is free of sexual harassment.

Every academic year ICC organizes minimum two meetings. ICC organizes different activities/ guest lecture to create awareness on sexual harassment and related issues. Details are tabulated in the following table.

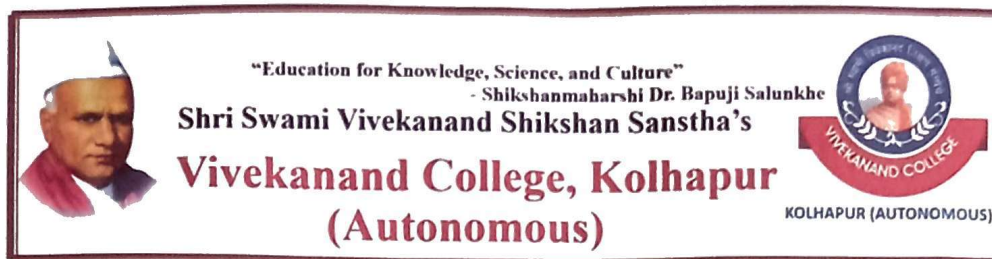

ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE

One Page Report (2022-2023)

College has formed anti-ragging committees and squads to combat the threat of ragging, maintain good relationships among students on campus, and enforce anti-ragging policies in compliance with directives from the Maharashtra government, UGC, and Supreme Court of India. Both indoors and outside, ragging is forbidden on college campuses. In an attempt to stop this, the anti-ragging committee and team have been working incredibly hard.

In accordance with UGC norms, the anti-ragging cell put up a Notice Board on college property that listed the guidelines for ragging occurrences and the related sanctions. In an effort to increase student awareness of the issue, posters with the names of the committee, squad, website, helpline, and anti-ragging rules and regulations are posted all over the college, including on notice boards, in departments, common areas, canteens, libraries, hostels, and on the websites of the colleges.

Additionally, from September 11 to October 11, 2022, a Google Form was used to organize an online quiz on anti-ragging awareness for all pupils. Both first-year and senior students have turned in the quiz. Via the Google form, every student has taken an anti-ragging oath. Based on the assessment of the quiz questions, we found that students shown an interest in learning about ragging, its consequences, and ways to avoid it.



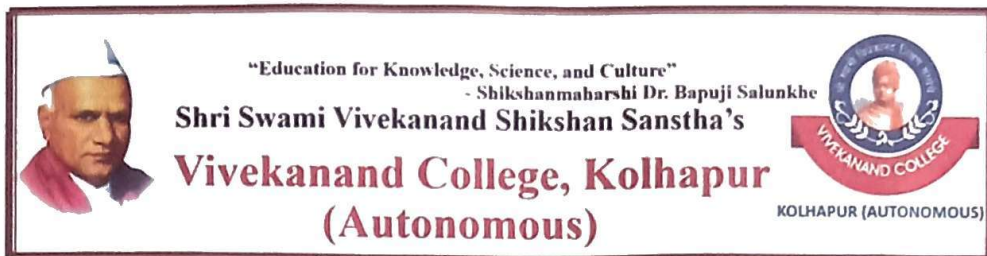

One Page Report (2021-2022)

In order to counteract the threat of ragging, foster positive connections between students on campus, and implement anti-ragging regulations in accordance with guidelines from the Maharashtra government, UGC, and Supreme Court of India, colleges have established anti-ragging committees and squads. Ragging is prohibited on college campuses, both indoors and outside. The anti-ragging team and committee have been working really hard to put an end to this.

A Notice Board listing the rules pertaining to ragging incidents and the associated penalties was erected on college property by the anti-ragging cell in compliance with UGC standards. 



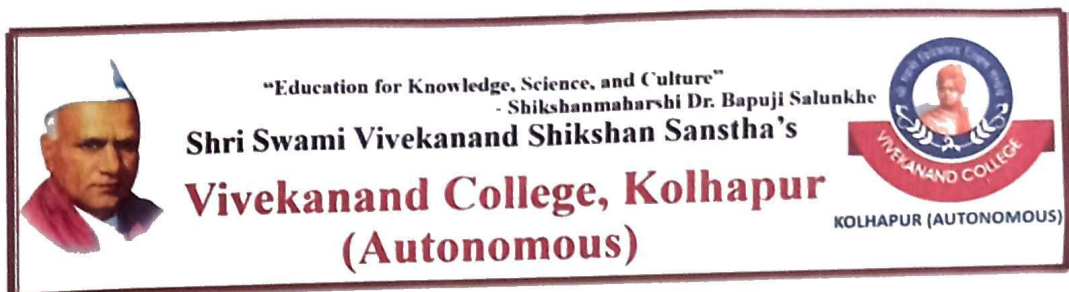

In order to eradicate the threat of ragging, foster positive student-to-student relationships on campus, and enforce anti-ragging policies in accordance with directives from the Maharashtra government, the UGC, and the Supreme Court of India, anti-ragging committee and squad have been established in college. On college campus, ragging is severely prohibited in both indoor and outdoor spaces. The anti-ragging committee and squad have been working hard to prevent this.

In accordance with UGC regulations, the anti-ragging cell put up a Notice Board on the college property with a list of the laws that relate to ragging incidents and the corresponding sanctions. Posters with names of the committee, squad, website, and helpline against ragging and anti-ragging rules and regulations are put all over the college, including on notice boards, in departments, common areas, canteens, libraries, hostels, and on the websites of the colleges, in an effort to increase student awareness of the issue.

The teachers in charge of new and returning student orientation and induction programs read aloud the anti-ragging policy to the students in their various classes in online mode throughout the week of January 5–14, 2021. With tremendous enthusiasm, every assigned faculty member participated in this awareness campaign. Each member of staff interacted with kids and told them that ragging was not permitted. 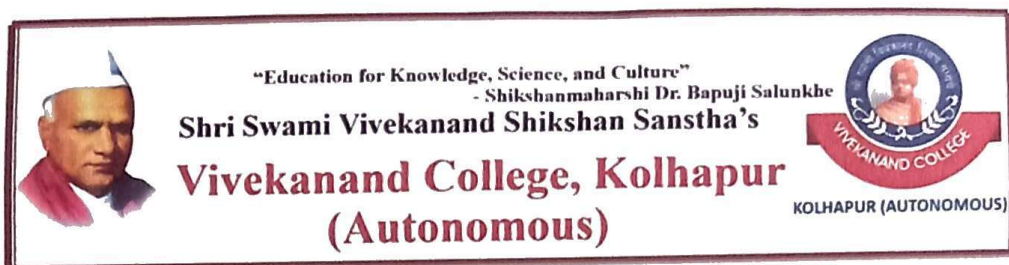



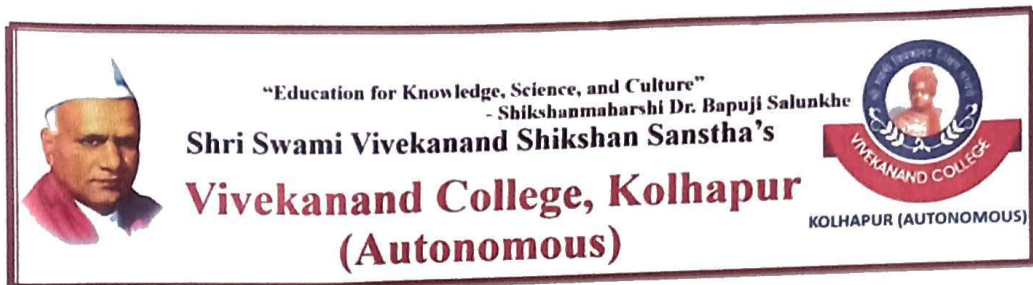
