Annual examination report for the AY 2022-23

In the academic year 2022-23 all UG/PG examinations were conducted through Offline/Online mode. In AY 2021-22 three examination sessions (Odd/Even) were carried out as December 2022, May-June 2023 and Make Up examination July-2023. More than 450 sessions were carried out in the examination session December 2022 and more than 750 sessions were carried out in the examination session May-June 2023 and 250 sessions were carried out in Make Up examination July-2023.

5062 students were appeared the examination in offline and online sessions December 2022 and 6851 students were attempted the examination in session May-June 2023 and 1978 students were attempted the examination in session Make Up examination July-2023 without any hassle.

At the very beginning to spread the awareness about autonomous college examinations among staff members One Day Workshop on "SANCTITY AND CONFIDENTIALITY OF EXAMINATION" has been arranged on 5-12-2022 and the details training was given to 116 teaching and non-teaching staff.

In the pre-examination process all the Notices were posted on Telegram groups as well as on college website. The 3 question sets of the question paper was prepared by the expert paper setters (Internal and External). The December 2022, May-June 2023 and Make Up examination July-2023 all sessions were carried out in Offline mode but Soft Skill Courses and Skill Enhancement papers were conducted in Online mode.

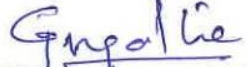
During all the sessions the Hall ticket, Summery Reports, Attendance sheets, Mark Sheets and all other reports were automatically generated from ERP Software.

The online exam sessions were conducted using proctor technology. For offline sessions internal and external senior supervisors were strictly monitoring every activity of each student also Flying Squad committee was appointed and the committee was keen to monitor whole examination process. The suspicious cases found during examination were called for the lapses committee meeting. 225 issues were resolved and the decisions were made by the lapses committee (meeting dated 04-02-2023, 15-03-2023, 20-06-2023 and 01-08-2023).

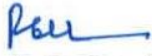


The examination cell has worked tirelessly and promptly declared the results of last year's students within an average of 28.62 days from the last date of examination. The pass percentage of final year students, excluding those with backlogs, during this academic year stands at 90.46%. Furthermore, during this academic year, a total of 11 students raised grievances related to paper re-evaluation out of the total number of appeared students. We have successfully resolved all the grievances in accordance with the regulations of the examination cell.

Total 60+ UG and 27 PG (May-June 2023 session) results were declared within 40 days by the team members. Total 2527 students were successfully passed in the exam session December 2022 and 4103 students were successfully passed in the examination session May-June 2023 and 955 students were successfully passed in the examination session Make Up examination July-2023. All the sessions were completed successfully and the results were sent to the University for Convocation process within time limit given by the Shivaji University, Kolhapur.

Annual examination report for the AY 2021-22

In the academic year 2021-22 the coronavirus i.e. COVID-19 pandemic was under control and as per the guidelines given by UGC, Ministry of HRDC, Maharashtra State Government and Shivaji University, Kolhapur, Vivekanand College has decided to conduct all UG/PG examinations through Offline/Online mode. In AY 2021-22 three examination sessions (Odd/Even) were carried out as Jan-Feb 2022, June-July 2022 and Make Up examination Oct-2022. Near about 400 sessions were carried out in the examination session Jan-Feb 2022 and more than 450 sessions were carried out in the examination session June-July 2022 and 350 sessions were carried out in Make Up examination Oct-2022.

4816 students were attempted the examination in session Jan-Feb 2022 and 5527 students were attempted the examination in session June-July 2022 and 1289 students were attempted the examination in session Make Up examination Oct-2022 without any hassle.

In the pre-exam process the Notices posted on Telegram groups and on website as well. The 3 question sets of the question paper was prepared by the expert paper setters (Internal and External). In Online examination during Jan-Feb 2022 session the questions were shuffled for every student in the examination. The question papers shall be set in such a manner as to ensure that they cover the entire syllabus as per the weightage of the modules of the concerned course unit. The June-July session was carried out in Offline mode but soft skill courses and Skill Enhancement papers were conducted in Online mode.

Jan-Feb 2022 online exam sessions were conducted using proctor technology, during each session the appointed internal and external senior supervisor was monitoring every activity of each student using proctoring technology. The suspicious cases found during examination, the grievances of the students who faced any technical difficulty like internet connectivity, electricity etc. and the students who were unable to attend the examination because of the flood were called for the lapses committee meeting. 186 issues were resolved and the decisions were made by the lapses committee (meeting dated 8-3-2022, 9-4-2022 and 30-11-2022).

During both the sessions the Hall ticket, Summery Reports, Attendance sheets, Mark Sheets and all other reports were automatically generated from ERP Software.




The examination cell has worked tirelessly and promptly declared the results of last year's students within an average of 23.64 days from the last date of examination. Furthermore, during this academic year, a total of 24 students raised grievances related to paper revaluation out of the total number of appeared students. We have successfully resolved all the grievances in accordance with the regulations of the examination cell. The pass percentage of final year students, excluding those with backlogs, during this academic year stands at 85.97%.

Total 40+ results were declared within 40 days by the team members. Total 3880 students were successfully passed in the exam session Jan-Feb 2022, total 3698 students were successfully passed in the examination session June-July 2022 and 1100 students were successfully passed in the examination session Make Up examination Oct-2022. Both the sessions were completed successfully and the results were sent to the University for Convocation process within time limit given by the Shivaji University, Kolhapur.

Annual examination report for the AY 2020-21

In the academic year 2020-21 the coronavirus i.e. COVID-19 pandemic was in its peak and during the epidemic as per the guidelines given by UGC, Ministry of HRDC, Maharashtra State Government and Shivaji University, Kolhapur, Vivekanand College has decided to conduct all UG/PG examinations through online mode. In AY 2020-21 two examination sessions (Odd/Even) were carried out as March-April 2021 and July-August 2021. More than 500 sessions were carried out and near about 4000 students were attempted the examination without any hassle. At the very beginning 4 Telegram groups were formed to reach each and every student. The 3 question sets of the question paper was prepared by the expert paper setters. The questions were shuffled for every student in the examination. The question papers shall be set in such a manner as to ensure that they cover the entire syllabus as per the weightage of the modules of the concerned course unit.

All examination conducted using proctor technology, during each session the appointed internal and external senior supervisor was monitoring every activity of each student using proctoring technology. The suspicious cases found during examination, the grievances of the students who faced any technical difficulty like internet connectivity, electricity etc. and the students who were unable to attend the examination because of the flood were called for the lapses committee meeting. 159 issues were resolved and the decisions were made by the lapses committee.

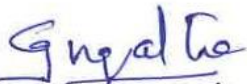
The major difficulty faced during exam session July-August 2021 is the flood situation occurred in major part of Kolhapur region as a result some papers were postponed and there were some delayed for the examination.


Again, the ERP was upgraded by the management and we were supposed to migrate the data from existing ERP to the new ERP. This was a challenging task for all the examination team to migrate the data without any single mistake. The team worked 24/7 for a month and without any mistake overall 1000+ cases were resolved and the results were declared within the given stipulated time limit.

The examination cell has worked tirelessly and promptly declared the results of last year's students within an average of 25.64 days from the last date of examination. Furthermore, during this academic year, a total of 10 students raised grievances related to paper re-evaluation out of the total number of appeared students. We have successfully resolved all the grievances in accordance with the regulations of the examination cell. The pass percentage of final year students, excluding those with backlogs, during this academic year stands at 95.17%.



Total 40+ results were declared within 8 days by the team members. The average number of days were 24.07. The number of students appeared were 1429. The number of students passed were 1360. The number of students failed were 69. The passing percentage was 95.17%. Both the sessions were completed successfully and the very first UG batch results were sent to the University for Convocation process within time limit given by the Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The Degree were awarded for all the final year completed students by mentioning Vivekanand College, Kolhapur (Autonomous) on their degree certificates.

Annual examination report for the AY 2019-20

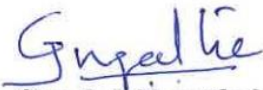
During academic year 2019-20 the first term examinations were conducted in offline mode. But in the second term due to the Covid-19 pandemic and subsequent lockdown in the month of April 2020 as per the guidelines given by UGC, Maharashtra State Government and Shivaji University, Kolhapur, Vivekanand College has decided to conduct UG/PG examinations of the Final Year Students through Online Mode. The main recommendations in the guidelines issued by UGC is for the final Semester Students will be graded based on internal assessment of the present and previous semester.

Vivekanand College adopted alternative and simplified modes and methods of examinations to complete the evaluation and gradation process in shorter period of time by reducing the time from 2 hours to 1 hour observing the guidelines of "social distancing" and keeping in view the support system available and ensuring fair opportunity to all students.

Another major difficulty faced during academic year 2019-20 is the flood situation occurred in major part of Kolhapur region. Because of the both Covid-19 and Flood there were delayed for the evaluation process and further result processing.

The examination cell has worked tirelessly and promptly declared the results of last year's PG students and second year UG students within an average of 19.07 days from the last date of examination. Furthermore, during this academic year, a total of 07 students raised grievances related to paper re-evaluation out of the total number of appeared students. We have successfully resolved all the grievances in accordance with the regulations of the examination cell. The pass percentage of PG final year students under autonomous college, excluding those with backlogs, during this academic year stands at 96.05%.

Both the sessions were completed successfully and the results were submitted to the University for Convocation process within time limit given by the Shivaji University, Kolhapur.

Annual examination report for the AY 2018-19

After the Vivekanand College became autonomous, the very first examination of the autonomous college was conducted in two sessions. In the two sessions of October-November 2018 and June-July 2019, all the examinations of Sem 1 and Sem 2 of the first year were properly planned and executed successfully. Paper setting, appointment of internal invigilator, external invigilator, appointment of all supervisors, CAP, evaluation process etc. were completed in time. As it was the very first autonomous exam, some difficulties were faced. The integrated examination planning program like second, third year university examination and first year autonomous examination was difficult but it was implemented with meticulous micro planning.

The examination was planned with three phases. In first phase i.e. the pre-exam processes the Notices casted on website and pasted on College Notice board as well. The 3 question sets of the question paper was prepared by the expert paper setters. One random question paper set was selected for the examination in the second phase the examination was conducted and in the third phase the assessment and moderation i.e. the CAP process was completed.

For both the sessions the Hall ticket, Summery Reports, Attendance sheets, Mark Sheets and all other reports were automatically generated from ERP Software.

The examination cell has worked tirelessly and promptly declared the results of first year's students within an average of 19.5 days from the last date of examination. Furthermore, during this academic year, a total of 08 students raised grievances related to paper revaluation out of the total number of appeared students. We have successfully resolved all the grievances in accordance with the regulations of the examination cell.


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
