

Courses in Research Methodology are offered at both graduate and post graduate levels in various fields such as English, Economics, History, Home Science, Accountancy, Costing, Business Administration, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Microbiology, and Statistics, as well as specialized programs like Foundry Technology. By incorporating research ethics into the research methodology coursework, the institution provides students with a strong foundation in ethical research practices, emphasizing the importance of integrity, responsibility, and adherence to ethical standards in their research endeavors.

For instance, in English and Economics programs, Research Methodology courses are offered in both the fifth and sixth semesters, ensuring that students receive continuous exposure to ethical research practices throughout their academic journey. In the sciences, such as Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, and Microbiology, research methodology courses are present in various semesters, which equip students with the tools to conduct research ethically in their respective fields. Similarly, in commerce and business administration programs, students are introduced to advanced accountancy and costing methodologies, emphasizing ethical considerations in financial and managerial research.

By embedding research ethics in the coursework across various disciplines, the institution not only educates students on the importance of ethical conduct but also cultivates a culture of ethical research throughout its academic community. This approach helps to prepare students to carry out responsible and ethical research in their future.

The Department of Geography also organized a twelve-day research methodology coursework in 2021-22, sanctioned by ICSSR, Delhi. This initiative further
