

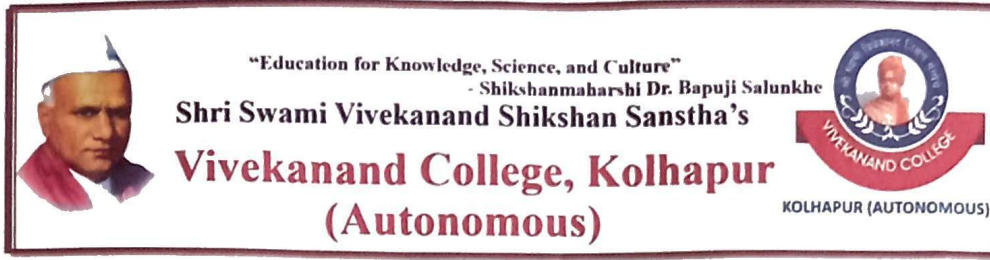

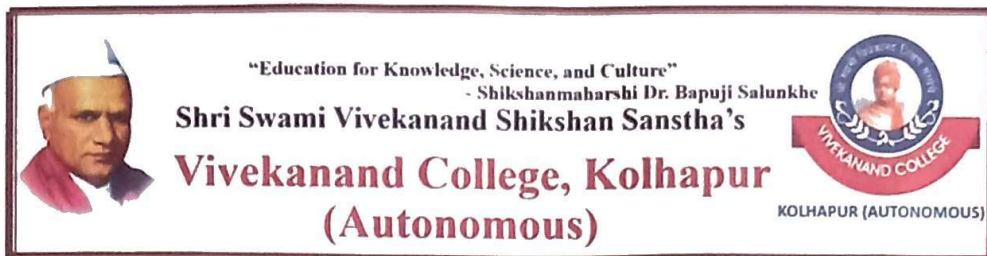
College has formed anti-ragging committees and squads to combat the threat of ragging, maintain good relationships among students on campus, and enforce anti-ragging policies in compliance with directives from the Maharashtra government, UGC, and Supreme Court of India. Both indoors and outside, ragging is forbidden on college campuses. In an attempt to stop this, the anti-ragging committee and team have been working incredibly hard.

In accordance with UGC norms, the anti-ragging cell put up a Notice Board on college property that listed the guidelines for ragging occurrences and the related sanctions. In an effort to increase student awareness of the issue, posters with the names of the committee, squad, website, helpline, and anti-ragging rules and regulations are posted all over the college, including on notice boards, in departments, common areas, canteens, libraries, hostels, and on the websites of the colleges.

Additionally, from September 11 to October 11, 2022, a Google Form was used to organize an online quiz on anti-ragging awareness for all pupils. Both first-year and senior students have turned in the quiz. Via the Google form, every student has taken an anti-ragging oath. Based on the assessment of the quiz questions, we found that students shown an interest in learning about ragging, its consequences, and ways to avoid it.

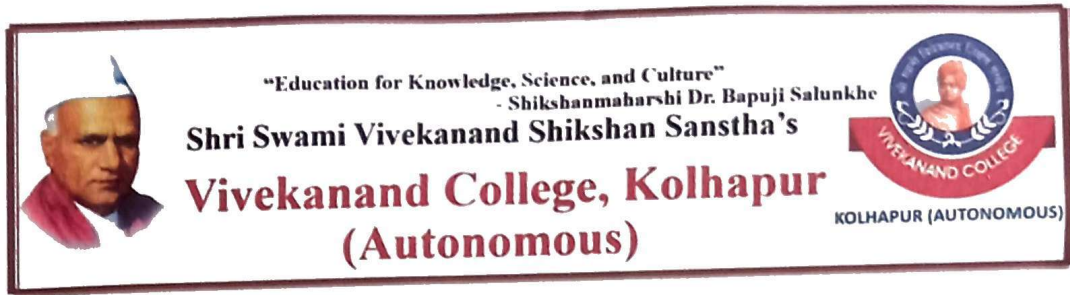
In order to counteract the threat of ragging, foster positive connections between students on campus, and implement anti-ragging regulations in accordance with guidelines from the Maharashtra government, UGC, and Supreme Court of India, colleges have established anti-ragging committees and squads. Ragging is prohibited on college campuses, both indoors and outside. The anti-ragging team and committee have been working really hard to put an end to this.

A Notice Board listing the rules pertaining to ragging incidents and the associated penalties was erected on college property by the anti-ragging cell in compliance with UGC standards. Throughout the college, including on notice boards, in departments, common areas, canteens, libraries, hostels, and on the websites of the colleges, posters bearing the names of the committee, squad, website, helpline, and anti-ragging rules and regulations are placed in an attempt to raise student awareness of the problem.

At the period of December 2, 2021, to December 11, 2021, the college ran an anti-ragging policy awareness program for fresher at induction and orientation as well as during their first classroom interaction. Every faculty member assigned to a student has engaged with them and informed them of the ban on ragging. In front of the students, the faculty members have also reviewed and read the college's anti-ragging policy. The college's anti-ragging strategy has piqued the interest of the students as well.

In accordance with UGC regulations, the anti-ragging cell put up a Notice Board on the college property with a list of the laws that relate to ragging incidents and the corresponding sanctions. Posters with names of the committee, squad, website, and helpline against ragging and anti-ragging rules and regulations are put all over the college, including on notice boards, in departments, common areas, canteens, libraries, hostels, and on the websites of the colleges, in an effort to increase student awareness of the issue.

The teachers in charge of new and returning student orientation and induction programs read aloud the anti-ragging policy to the students in their various classes in online mode throughout the week of January 5–14, 2021. With tremendous enthusiasm, every assigned faculty member participated in this awareness campaign. Each member of staff interacted with kids and told them that ragging was not permitted. After reviewing the policy, faculty members reported their presence in the classes in which they engaged in online mode. A great number of students indicated that they would like to understand the college's anti-ragging policy. No instances of harassment were reported during his academic year as a result of the committee's and the squad members' efforts.
